Overview of Human Services provided in Utah

- In the State of Utah, the provision of substance abuse, mental health and senior service programs is the responsibility of county government - otherwise referred to as the **Local Authority**.
 - Counties often join together to provide some or all of these services
 - The region created to provide these services is called a **catchment** area.
 - WHS's catchment area is comprised of Weber County and Morgan County
 - Weber Human Services is the only organization in the State of Utah that provides substance abuse, mental health and senior services under a single administration.

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Weber Human Services is an Independent Entity

- Mental Health, Substance Abuse and Senior Services were provided directly by Weber County Government from the late 1960's through 1993.
- In August of 1993, the County Commissioners from Weber and Morgan Counties established Weber Human Services to provide human services in Weber and Morgan Counties.



WHS Board of Directors

- The WHS Board of Directors is composed of:
 - Three Weber County Commissioners
 - Two Morgan County Council members
 - One Mental Health Services community representative
 - One Senior Services community representative
 - One Substance Abuse Services community representative

- The Board of Directors has responsibility to:
 - Hire an Executive Director accountable to the Board
 - Set policy and procedures
 - Approve contracts and purchase orders
 - Approve the budget
 - Take action on issues of local and state interest
 - Comply with Department of Human Services directives regarding the oversight, use, and expenditure of state and federal funds
